<p><b>Phonics</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Read your school reading book to focus on blending sounds. Remember to write in your school reading record!</li> <li>• Practise your spellings.</li> <li>• Play 'Fast Phonics' online on Reading Eggs using your log in.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Reading</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pick a book from home and read it to a family member, pet or favourite toy. Draw and write about your favourite part of the story. Make sure you explain why you like it!</li> <li>• Play 'Reading Eggs' online using your login.</li> </ul>	<p><b>English</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• This week we have been learning how to describe toys. Pick a favourite toy. Write some sentences describing your toy. Underline the adjectives. Can you use the joining word 'and' in a sentence?</li> <li>• Reread your writing and check that you have perfect sentences (capital letters, finger spaces and full stops).</li> </ul>	<p><b>Maths</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pick items in your house to measure using a non-standard unit of measurement (your hand, a paper clip, a pencil or crayon etc). How will you record this? Which object is the longest / shortest? How do you know?</li> <li>• Play 'Mathseeds' online using your Reading Eggs login.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Creative</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• We have done lots of learning all about plants so far this term. You have drawn flowers and plants but what do they look like with snow on? Draw a snowy plant picture.</li> </ul>	<p><b>DT</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Help an adult to make lunch. Record instructions to help someone else make the same snack or meal. Take photos and send into <a href="mailto:yr1@greenvale.medway.sch.uk">yr1@greenvale.medway.sch.uk</a></li> </ul>	<p><b>Outdoors</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Wrap up warm and go for a snowy walk.</li> <li>• Look at your footprints – what patterns can you see?</li> <li>• Can you take snowy photos on your adult's phone?
