Before we can learn to sound out words and become word readers, we need to be experts at making different sounds. Share a story together, add sound effects to your story, these could be squeaking doors, animals or triptrapping footsteps.

Let's get making!

Create a playdough model, picture or mask of your favourite character from a story. Take a picture of this and email it to nursery. Can you tell me 'why' you like this character? Can you tell me 'how' you made your picture?

Listening time

Pop on over to the school website and listen to some of the wonderful stories that have been recorded for you. What was your favourite part of the story? Can you remember what happened FIRST, THEN, FINALLY? Use the 'STORY TALK' words to help you?

Be a story changer!

Read a story a home or use one from the website.

Now have a go at changing it!!

Why not pretend you are in the story instead? If your story is about a cat, why not change it to a T-REX! Now etell your story! Ask an adult o write it down or record it o share with us.
