

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We have been looking at the grapheme 'ea'. Can you create some silly sentences with our words this week? Bleak, break, clean, gleam, great, sneak, speak, steak, steam. How many of these words can you find in a book? Can you find any other words with 'ea' in the middle? 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Read your school reading book. Do you have a favourite book at home? Perhaps you could draw a picture of your favourite part and explain why. Do you have a Christmas story to read and tell us about? 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Create a description of what Plop looks like using adjectives and adverbs. For example: Plop has fluffy feathers and rapidly flies from his branch. Can you remember and write facts about owls? 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Practice writing numbers from 0-100. Practice your 2, 5, and 10 times tables. Solve these subtraction problems using the number line attached to help. $57 - 9 =$ $23 - 6 =$ $64 - 6 =$ $31 - 4 =$ $43 - 7 =$ $41 - 5 =$ $39 - 6 =$ $72 - 9 =$ $98 - 9 =$ $61 - 8 =$

Can you create any accessories or a background for the puppet you have designed in DT. For instance, a jungle picture for a tiger puppet or a collar for a cat puppet. The puppet will be the size of your hand. 	<p>Thinking of the myths we listened to; Scotland – the Loch Ness monster, Ireland – The Giant's causeway, Wales – King Arthur's Knights and England – Robin Hood.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Create music using items around your kitchen and home. It could be water in a bottle swishing back and forth, keys jangling, card wiggled for wind etc. 	<p>We looked at Neil Armstrong this week and his 'One small step for man, one giant leap for mankind' step onto the Moon.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> What would it be like if you were on a journey to Mars? What would it feel like? What do you think Mars surface would feel like? Create a description of your journey to Mars. Write a diary entry of what it would be like to be the first person in History to step onto Mars. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> In a safe space. Can you create your own gymnastic routine like we did this week? 1) Travel – frog or Monkey move. 2) Present. 3) Then your choice of moves: tree, warrior, curve, plank, tall or small and 4) present to finish.
