<p>Personal, Social and Emotional Development</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Play a game or activity with someone at home. ○ Can you take turns? ○ Can you work together to build something from duplo/Lego? ○ Work together to build a snowman. ○ Make different faces in the mirror, happy, sad, excited, cross. Talk about what makes you feel that way. 	<p>Communication, Language and Literacy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Talk about what you can see in a picture from a walk outside/book/photo on a phone. ○ Challenge your child to use a whole sentence or to link a sentence together with a word such as 'and' or 'because'. ○ If your child is yet to use sentences then support them by adding 1 thing to what they say. EG "snowman" "Yes a big snowman." 	<p>Physical Development</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Use your big and little muscle movements to make lines/circles/wobbly lines/letters in the snow. ○ Try to copy some shapes or letters. ○ Have a go at writing the first letter of your name. ○ Play a game of musical statues or musical bumps to some Christmas Music. 	
<p>Literacy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Share your school story, a book from home or watch an episode of CBeebies bedtime stories. ○ Pause the story and talk about what might be happening and whay might happen next. ○ Talk through the book using only the pictures. ○ Draw your favourite part. 	<p>Mathematics</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Make footprints in the snow. Count as you do it. ● Whose are bigger/smaller? ● Go on a treasure hunt at home. Find something big/small, tall/short, heavy/light, full/empty. ● Sort some odd socks into pairs, talk about the pattern. ● Sing some number rhymes. 	<p>Understanding the World</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Explore the weather using your senses. ● Describe how it feels, what can you see, what do you smell? ● How does the world look? Is it the same or different to yesterday? ● Talk about your own life history? Look back through old photos and videos of yourself on a phone, how are you the same or different? 	<p>Expressive Arts and Design</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Create a wonderful snowy picture. ● Maybe make some cards or design some wrapping paper. ● Use your toys or boxes at home to make the North Pole! ● Pretend to be Father Christmas or an Elf.
