

Owl Class Home Learning for a Snowy Day. Choose from the following activities...

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Phonics</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sound search. Use your school reading book to look for words containing your focus sound/s (the back of the book will tell you what this is). How many words can you find? Don't forget to write in your school reading record!</li> <li>• Play 'Fast Phonics' online on Reading Eggs using your log in.</li> </ul>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Reading</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Read your school reading book</li> <li>• Do you have a favourite book at home? Perhaps you could draw a picture of your favourite part and write about why you like it.</li> <li>• Play 'Reading Eggs' online using your login.</li> </ul>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>English</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Write your own story about a snowy day. How will your story start (One snowy day, once upon a time etc). Make sure your story has a beginning, middle and end.</li> <li>• Reread your story and check that you have perfect sentences (capital letters, finger spaces and full stops).</li> </ul>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Maths</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pick a number (to 9). Write down everything you know about that number. Now add 10 to that number and write down everything you know about your new number. What is the same? What is different?</li> <li>• Play 'Mathseeds' online using your Reading Eggs login.</li> </ul>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Creative</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Can you draw or paint a snowy picture?</li> </ul>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Science</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Collect a pot of snow and bring it inside. How long does it take to melt?</li> <li>• Try placing pots of snow in different places and compare how long it takes them to melt.</li> </ul>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Outdoors</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Wrap up warm and go for a snowy walk</li> <li>• Can you build a snowman?</li> <li>• Look at your footprints – what patterns can you see?</li> <li>• Can you take snowy photos on your adult's phone?
