Our day can vary slightly depending on the individual needs of our pupils.








What have we been learning?

Over the last term we have been learning;

- To follow new rules and boundaries.
- To work alongside others and begin to make friends and compromises.
- To begin to express our needs and feelings.
- To get used to unfamiliar adults in a new setting.

The stories we have shared



From next term, we will begin to read with pupils individually. We will aim to sit and share a story book with each pupil on a 1:1 basis. This book will then be sent home to share over the weekend and should be returned to school on Monday of the following week.

Next Term

Now that we know our pupils better, we will be able to support their learning much better. Each week we will select 5-6 pupils to monitor, observe and support more closely. This will be done predominantly through their play. You will receive a form to complete the week before and would like this to be returned ASAP the following week.

Things to remember

- Children return to school on Monday 1st November.
- Due to the demolition of the old nursery building, our usual route to nursery will be out of bounds. Children will need to be collected via the back gate. (see separate letter.)
